## Open Call for hcmoff 2015: Concert Of Rejects

Did you have an application for the Huddersfield Contemporary Music Festival Shorts 2015 rejected? Then we want to hear from you!

**hcmoff 2015: Concert Of Rejects** is a fringe event of the Huddersfield Contemporary Music Festival and is in no way affiliated with the festival itself. **hcmoff** aims to provide up-and-coming musicians with a valuable platform to perform for members of the public, media and key music industry representatives whilst these parties are resident in Huddersfield during UK's leading new music Festival.

For its inaugural event, **hcmoff** requests works which were rejected for the HCMF Shorts in 2015, to be performed in a fringe event happening in Huddersfield during the main festival. If you have applied for an HCMF Shorts slot in 2015 and been rejected, we want to hear from you! We will program a selection of rejected proposals on **26**<sup>th</sup> **November 2015** at **18:30** in **Coffee Kabin, 37-39 Queensgate, (opposite the University)** in Huddersfield during the festival.

#### **The Selection Process**

Our selection of works will be completely transparent. We will publish a list of the names, descriptions of work, and projected travel costs of all applicants (both rejected and successful) following our selection, along with how and why they were selected or rejected.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible to play at this **hcmoff** concert you must:

- 1. Have applied and been rejected for the HCMF Shorts 2015.
- 2. Not be playing in any HCMF concert in 2015.
- 3. Apply with EXACTLY the same proposal as for HCMF Shorts 2015 (new proposals will not be accepted).
- 4. Use your slot at **hcmoff** to perform the proposal given on your rejected application for HCMF Shorts 2015.
- 5. Agree to the publication of your name, the description of the work and projected travel costs you provide on the application form, along with whether your application was accepted or rejected.

In line with the original HCMF Shorts rules:

Proposals are welcomed from all types of performers, and works can be especially composed or existing pieces. There are no age limits. Proposed programmes should be no longer than 20 minutes in duration.

#### hcmoff will provide:

- Music stands, chairs and microphones (on request)
- A small PA system
- An electric piano (on request)
